### MOBILE DEVICE POLICY

- Those wishing to use their mobile devices will be asked to adjust the volume setting to "silent" or "vibrate" while at the Championship.
- Guests may accept or make phone calls in designated areas throughout the golf course, primarily near concession stands.
- Digital messaging and checking data is allowed on the golf course.
- Mobile device camera use is permitted during the Practice Rounds only.
- No video recording will be permitted at any time during Championship Week.

Spectators attempting to use their mobile device in unauthorized areas or in ways not sanctioned will be asked to surrender the device and pick it up at a designated location after they depart the golf course.

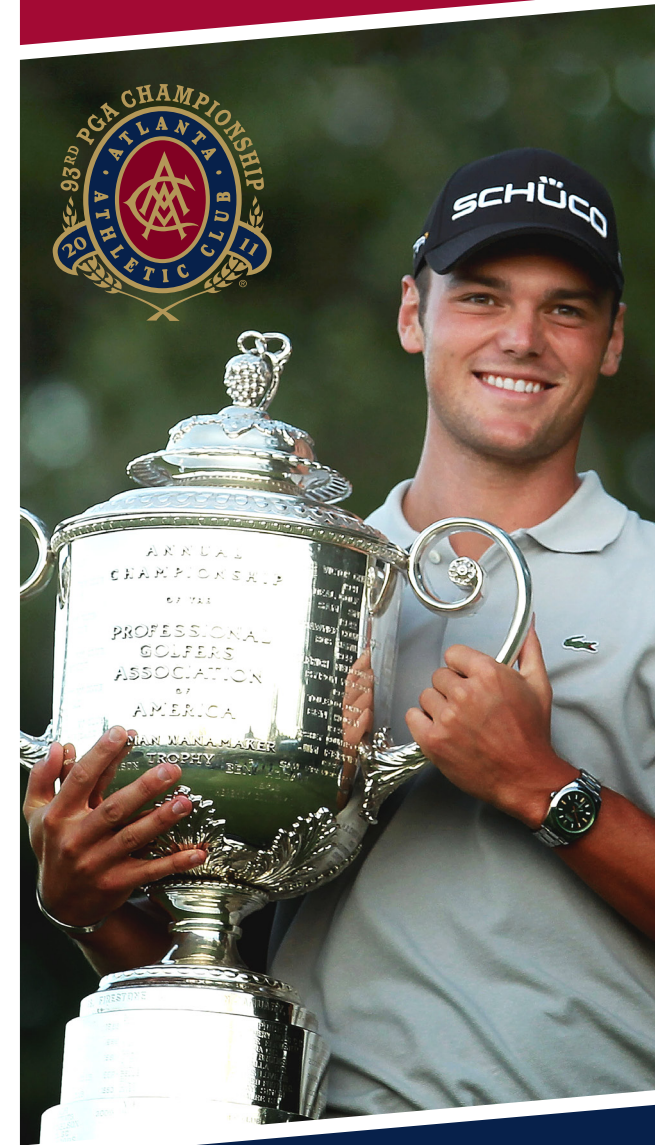

# GENERAL SPECTATOR INFORMATION

## PHOTOS / AUTOGRAPHS

Cameras are only allowed onsite during Practice Rounds, Monday through Wednesday, and are not permitted at the Championship during Championship Rounds, Thursday through Sunday. Autographs may be requested and given at the contestants' convenience at the Practice Range and Putting Green during Practice Rounds only.

## RE-ADMISSION POLICY

A ticket, once scanned, will no longer gain admission to the Championship. If you plan to return to Atlanta Athletic Club the same day, please have security stamp your hand at the Main Spectator Entrance. You will be able to return to the grounds with a scanned ticket and a hand stamp. The only exception is when the Weather Warning signs are posted which requires an evacuation of the golf course. In this situation, a hand stamp will not be required to return to the Championship.

## CHAMPIONSHIP PROGRAM

93rd PGA Championship programs are available for purchase in the Championship Golf Shop for \$10 each.

## CONDUCT, CUSTOMS AND ETIQUETTE

Please be advised of the following standards of conduct and etiquette:

- Everyone is requested to display traditional customs of etiquette, decorum and behavior, and to obey all Championship policies, signs and verbal instructions of Championship officials. Protests of any type are forbidden.
- For the safety of everyone and in keeping with policy established at major sporting events, running is considered to be unacceptable behavior.
- Although cheering and positive spectator responses to great play are encouraged, unsolicited and consistent calls from the gallery are prohibited.
- Please stay behind the gallery ropes and cooperate with the Marshals.
- Please kneel or sit if you are in the front row and remain still throughout each shot.

## JUNIORS GET IN FREE!

To provide the ultimate family entertainment value, The PGA of America is excited to offer up to four (4) complimentary junior ground admissions with every paid adult ticket. Junior admissions apply to youth age 17 or younger, and may be obtained at the Admission Sales & Will Call Office on the day of entry. Wanamaker ticket upgrades for juniors may be purchased for \$20 per day at the Admission Sales & Will Call Office at the Main Spectator Entrance. Junior tickets do not gain access into private hospitality areas.

## COMPLIMENTARY ACCESS FOR MILITARY

To honor the men and women who serve our country in the Armed Forces, The PGA of America is pleased to offer active and retired military personnel complimentary daily grounds access to the PGA Championship. A valid military ID is required on the day of attendance to receive the free ticket, which can be obtained at the Admission Sales & Will Call Office located at the Main Spectator Entrance.

## ITEMS TO LEAVE AT HOME

The items listed below are strictly prohibited on the grounds of the PGA Championship. All bags will be searched upon entry.

- Personal electronics such as hand-held games, radios, televisions (including hand-held), iPods, etc.
- All oversized chairs with wide arm rests (small, portable/folding chairs are permitted).
- Weapons of any kind (regardless of permit), including pocket knives.
- Bags larger than 12" x 12" x 12" in their natural state.
- Bikes, coolers, ladders, milk crates, signs, posters, banners, dogs and other pets.
- Food and beverages (including alcoholic beverages).
- Other items deemed unlawful or dangerous by PGA Championship Security Personnel, at their sole discretion.

If a spectator brings any of the above items to the PGA Championship, they will not be allowed admittance to the event and will be asked to return the prohibited item to their point of origin.

## INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY FOR SPECTATORS

Please observe the Leader Boards and Thru Boards for the Weather Warning Sign which will appear when inclement weather is approaching the site. When the signs appear, spectators are advised to take precautions and seek shelter PRIOR to play being suspended. If the sirens sound, seek shelter immediately.

## COMPLIMENTARY PUBLIC PARKING

Complimentary parking at the Arena at Gwinnett Center along with air-conditioned motor coach service to and from the Main Spectator Entrance are included for all Championship spectators. NO hangtag will be required to access the free parking lot on a daily basis. The Gwinnett Center Arena is located at 6400 Sugarloaf Parkway, Duluth, GA, 30097.

## DIRECTIONS TO PGA PARKING

### FROM THE SOUTH:

Follow I-85 North to exit 108, Sugarloaf Parkway. Stay in the right lane on exit ramp and turn right at Sugarloaf Parkway. Follow PGA Public Parking signage towards the entrance to the Gwinnett Center Arena.

### FROM THE NORTH:

Follow I-85 South to exit 109, Sugarloaf Parkway/Old Peachtree Rd. Take the Sugarloaf Parkway exit and turn right at Sugarloaf Parkway. Follow PGA Public Parking signage towards the entrance to the Gwinnett Center Arena.

### FROM THE EAST:

Follow Sugarloaf Parkway west-bound past I-85. Follow PGA Public Parking signage towards the entrance to the Gwinnett Center Arena.

### FROM THE WEST:

Follow Sugarloaf Parkway east-bound towards I-85. Follow PGA Public Parking signage towards the entrance to the Gwinnett Center Arena.

## PUBLIC DROP-OFF & PICK-UP

All unauthorized vehicles will be directed to the general public parking lot for drop-off and pick-up. There is NO curbside drop-off or pick-up point at the Atlanta Athletic Club.

## MOBILITY IMPAIRED PARKING

Designated parking for mobility impaired spectators will be provided. Please call The Convention Store at (877) 472-7275 for more information. Wheelchairs will not be available for rent, but spectators may bring wheelchairs with them to the Championship.

Wheelchair accessible viewing areas will be located at the Practice Range, short right of the 18th Green and left of the #1 Tee.

## UPGRADED PARKING AVAILABLE

A limited quantity of daily and weekly upgraded parking is available for the 93rd PGA Championship. Upgraded parking passes MUST be purchased in advance.
